HUNTER SAFETY:

- All students are required to complete New York State Hunter Education

- There is a \$20 fee for this course and this can be paid by the club for new students
 - A code is used to pay for the course- see one of the coaches if you feel you need this and do not have it.
- This takes time to complete- please do not procrastinate

SCHEDULE:

- Practice: Thursday 2:30pm-5:00pm (or until finished) & Sunday 1:00pm-4:30pm (or until finished) at Galway Fish & Game Club
 - SIGN UPS: online slots in google classroom
 - Students will sign up for one relay per competition/practice week on either Thursday or Sunday
 - Students will shoot 50 shots per relay slot

Attendance Policy

- Students are responsible for signing up AND also removing your name from slots you
 can not make. Students have 24 hours prior to relay to cancel without penalty.
- If you do not call ahead and do not show for 2 practices you will be removed from the team
 - This is to ensure that the time the team members and coaches dedicate is respected.

• Reserve Week:

- Scores are used in case of a missed competition week
- Reasons to use a reserve week score: sickness/quarantine, weather cancels practice, family emergencies ect.
- o 50 shots

• Competition:

- o 5 weeks
- 50 shots per week
- Students can practice extra during these weeks but only if there is time and space
- Scores are recorded and submitted by coaches to NYS Clay Target
 - You can view results through you athlete management account
- Students must compete in all 5 weeks for their score to count toward their team and individual averages
 - Exceptions are made for sickness/quarantine/emergencies and one of the practice week scores can be used.

Additional Practice Times:

- Thursday nights at 6:30pm Fish House Fish and Game Club (opens May)
 - Students must use own ammo
 - \$5 per round
- Sunday morning 9am Galway Fish and Game Club
 - Students must use own ammo
 - No fee for students on the team

EQUIPMENT:

Firearms

- Must never be on school property
- Parent or guardian can bring a firearm to use
- Multiple team firearms available to use for practice and competition
- o 12 & 20 gauge are the most commonly used, occasionally .410

Patterning

- We strongly recommend patterning new firearms before a student starts to shoot with it.
- Patterning helps determine where the firearm shoots relative to the sight picture.
- If you are bringing a new (or new to you) firearm to use at practice/competition please
 arrive 15-20 minutes early and let one of the coaches know so that we can do this
 before practice starts.

Ammunition Pouches

- Donated by Pheasants Forever
- o All pouches stay at the range when not in use
- Students are welcome to bring their own pouches if they choose

Ammunition

- Shotgun ammunition is currently very hard to allocate for the team
- Students will be limited to 4 boxes (100 rounds total) per week at no cost
 - This may change depending on students enrolled and ammunition availability,
- Parents/students are welcome to bring their own ammunition for more practice during the season

Clay Targets/Clay Birds

All clay targets for practice and competition are donated by Galway Fish & Game Club

Safety Glasses

- All students must have eye protection when shooting on the line
- Safety glasses are provided at no cost and are available at the range
- Please bring this pair with you for each practice/competition

Hearing Protection

- All students are required to have ear/hearing protection on the line when shooting
- We advise any spectators or students within 25 feet of the firing line to wear hearing protection as well
- Reusable ear plugs are available at the range at all times
- o Students are welcome to bring their own hearing protection if they wish

Clothing

- Dress appropriately for the weather- this includes rain
- o Close-toed shoes
- Gloves are encouraged for cold weather

Range bag

- Range bags are not required but can be a useful item for students to purchase.
- This can help hold any equipment: safety glasses, hearing protection ect that you may need at each practice

TEAM RULES:

1. ATTENDANCE:

- Students must attend 1 practice per week and all competition weeks
- Students are responsible for signing up AND also removing your name from slots unable to make it
- If you do not call ahead and do not show for 2 practices you will be removed from the team
 - This is to ensure that the time the team members and coaches dedicate is respected.

• Please e-mail or use Remind to text coach Heather or Coach Colleen if there is a reason you will not be attending.

2. INELIGIBILITY LIST:

- If you are on the ineligibility list at school you are not allowed to practice or compete for 2 weeks or until you have been removed from the list.
- Keep in mind that 2 weeks out of competition would take you off the team for the season.

3. MASKS/COVID:

- Follow current school guidelines at all times
- If you are not feeling well please DO NOT come to the range
 - This includes parents/guardians and students
 - Text/email coach as soon as possible

4. OFFICERS:

- As we are a club sport, every season we must elect club officers:
 - President/Vice President/Treasurer
- These will be elected at the start of the spring season every year
 - In the case of graduated seniors- those positions will be filled when needed.

AWARDS:

- Athletic Lettering:
 - Available for grades 9-12
 - Students in 7-8th grade can receive a school letter if their average competition score is in the top 50% for the Galway Trap Team
 - Students must complete the following:
 - Compete in all competition weeks
 - Homeschool students are not eligible at this time

- Will be given out at the end of each season at the banquet
- Awards include:
 - Highest competition average male and female
 - Most improved male and female
 - Highest average for each grade level
