**Encore Classes**: would run like they do in 7th and 8th grade; 4 sections of each encore class- 2 classes will run every other day in the fall and the other two will run every other day in the Spring (For example:

- Fall Semester: Music: A-Days and Art: B-Days
- Spring Semester: H &C: A-Days and Tech: B-Days

<u>Lunch:</u> 6th grade could eat in MS Gym (Looking to see if we can fit in the Cafeteria); 7th and 8th grade in the HS cafeteria

### AIS Reading/Math:

- Meet every other day
- 2 sections of Reading and 2 sections of Math

**Resource**: Special Education students are scheduled for Resource

**<u>Learning Lab:</u>** Teachers are working directly with the rest of the students not placed in AIS or Resource

<u>Advisory Period:</u> Teachers are working directly with students on RULER and Study Skills every other day <u>Spanish</u>: There would be 4 sections (2 different Spanish teachers) of **Introductory** Spanish on the opposite day (not graded)

**ELA Lab**: Traditionally, the 6th grade teachers always had an extra period of ELA built in (writing, IReady, etc,)
