| SUPERINTENDENT'S REPORT | An annual Board of Education retreat was held on August 19 th with Mr. Moses, Mr. Marcelle, Interim Superintendent, some administrators, etc. in attendance. They talked about the facilities plan, with a goal of having a district vote on December 15 ^{th.} The community will be asked to approve a building project just under \$5,000,000 with no tax impact on the local taxpayer. The project will consist of mainly school improvements and security issues. Further details will be presented at a public meeting on September 23, 2009 which the Board established at this meeting.
