EBT will be supporting the Student Council on a **Spring Fundraiser**. The goal is to sell 200 tickets for \$50.00 a ticket. A drawing will take place the night of Friday, June 1st. First prize \$2000.00, second prize \$1,000.00 and third prize \$500.00. The Committee is brainstorming other prizes to give away as well. Teachers will be sent an email at the end of the day with any changes to a child's dismissal schedule. Bus drivers will also have access to an updated list. Michelle will offer a few times to parents if they want to see a demo on how it works. The school will now have a time stamp for every child.
