EMERGENCY RESOLUTION

WHEREAS, the Galway Central School District (the "School District") unexpectedly experienced severe wind damage to the pavilion at its school building located at 5317 Sacandaga Road, Galway, New York 12074; and

WHEREAS, as a result of this unforeseen event, the pavilion has been severely damaged and will continue to be damaged unless the School District repairs and reconstructs it immediately; and

WHEREAS, the damage to the pavilion will worsen and will continue to interfere with the School District's operations unless repaired and reconstructed immediately; and

WHEREAS, immediate repair and reconstruction of the pavilion is required to preserve the property of the School District and to assure the health and safety of students, staff and the community on the School District's property.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THIS BOARD OF EDUCATION AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. The Board of Education determines that the current condition of the pavilion at the School District's school building located at 5317 Sacandaga Road, Galway, New York 12074 is a condition that affects the health and safety of students, staff and the community using the School District's facilities, and that the repair and reconstruction of the pavilion must be taken immediately to preserve the School District's property and to safeguard the health and safety of students, staff and the community using the School District's facilities. The Board of Education hereby further determines that the repair and reconstruction of the pavilion, to the extent not covered by insurance, is a non-recurring, ordinary contingent expense that is necessary to preserve the School District's property and to assure the health and safety of students, staff and the community.

- Section 2. The School District is hereby authorized to undertake the repair and reconstruction of the pavilion, and to expend from the General Fund an amount not to exceed \$150,000.00 for such purpose in addition to any insurance proceeds received by the School District in connection with the damage to the pavilion.
- Section 3. The Superintendent of Schools is hereby authorized to file any necessary and proper paperwork with the State Education Department to proceed with the emergency repair and reconstruction and to work with the School District's architect, legal counsel, and other resources to immediately accomplish this action.

<u>Section 4.</u> Due to the emergency situation, a contract for the repair and reconstruction of the pavilion must be awarded immediately. Therefore, the School District is authorized to forego using competitive bidding for the repair and reconstruction.

<u>Section 5</u>. This Resolution shall take effect immediately upon its adoption.

SEQRA RESOLUTION

WHEREAS, the Galway Central School District (the "School District") unexpectedly experienced severe wind damage to the pavilion at its school building located at 5317 Sacandaga Road, Galway, New York; and

WHEREAS, the School District has proposed to undertake, on an emergency basis, a project consisting of the repair and reconstruction of the pavilion due to the damage ("the Project"); and

WHEREAS, the Board of Education wishes to fully comply with its obligations under the State Environmental Quality Review Act ("SEQRA") and the regulations thereunder with respect to the proposed action, in its capacity as Lead Agency; and

WHEREAS, the Board of Education has carefully considered the nature and scope of the proposed action; and

WHEREAS, upon review of the foregoing, the Board makes the following determinations:

- 1. The proposed action involves the repair and reconstruction of the pavilion due to the damage.
- 2. The damaged condition of the pavilion affects the health and safety of students, staff and the community using the School District's facilities, and the repair and reconstruction of the pavilion must be taken immediately to preserve the School District's property and to assure the health and safety of students, staff and the community.
- 3. The repair and reconstruction of the pavilion is immediately necessary, on a limited and temporary basis, for the protection and preservation of life, health, and property, is directly related to the emergency presented, and is to be performed to cause the least change or disturbance practicable under the circumstances.
- 4. The proposed project represents an emergency action within the meaning of 6 NYCRR 617.5(c)(33); and/or maintenance or repair involving no substantial changes in an existing facility or structure within the meaning of 6 NYCRR 617.5(c)(1); and/or alternatively the replacement, rehabilitation or reconstruction of a structure or facility in kind within the meaning of 6 NYCRR 617.5(c)(2).
 - 5. The proposed action will in no case have a significant adverse impact on the

environment based on the criteria contained in 6 NYCRR § 617.7(c), and is not otherwise a Type I action as defined by 6 NYCRR § 617.4.

6. The proposed action is a Type II action within the meaning of 6 NYCRR 617.5 and is therefore not subject to review under SEQRA and the regulations thereunder.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, that the Board finds and concludes that the proposed action is a Type II action within the meaning of 6 NYCRR 617.5 and therefore is not subject to review under SEQRA and the regulations thereunder.
