We hope everyone had a great summer, and you will soon settle into the school routine. While there are still challenges from COVID, we're in a much better place than last September. It's wonderful to have all our students back in school full time. We're also welcoming lots of new students and faculty. PTSA is once again planning in-person events, including Book Fairs, Family Fun Nights, and the Holiday Gift Shop. These events are subject to cancellation at short notice if COVID is more prevalent in the county, but we choose to be optimistic.

Our PTSA Officers were busy over the summer working on the budget, scheduling, and planning events, attending a NYS PTA conference, and getting up to date with everything. We have planners for faculty, and donated water, Gatorade, crackers, and children's underwear to the school nurses. Winners of our Elementary School Sunflower Growing Contest will be announced soon.

Our PTSA Dance program is open for enrollment. Classes begin September 14. Last year because of COVID, we had to find an alternative location for classes and there was only time and space for our competition team. This year, when space in the school is at a premium, we are very grateful to the Galway United Methodist Church for giving us a temporary home which can accommodate everyone. Masks and social distancing policies will be the most stringent of either the Galway CSD or Galway United Methodist Church. This will include no parents in the building during classes. Full details are available online.

Our first monthly meeting is on Monday, September 13, at the Cock 'N' Bull in Galway, starting at 6:15pm. This is open to everyone, member or not. We will be setting out some of our goals for the year and voting on our budget. We aim to keep this meeting short because we are also having our Volunteer Awards ceremony at 7pm. We have chosen three outstanding members of our community who give much of their time for the benefit of our young people. They will all receive Honorary Life Memberships to NYS PTA. Congratulations and thank you to Mark Bombard, Amy Thompson, and Crystal Walker. We are also recognizing the hard work and dedication of the awesome Galway CSD Food Service Team, (led by Amy Thompson). These ladies are always working hard, but during the last eighteen months they have gone above and beyond to make sure no Galway child goes hungry. We are thanking our current committee Chairpersons, without whom we could not run our events. After the awards, there will be refreshments and appetizers for all. Time to meet our PTSA Officers, community members and other parents. We would appreciate an RSVP if you would like to attend, so we can give the Cock N Bull an accurate head count for food. You do not have to sit through the meeting to attend the awards. You are welcome to arrive at 7pm.

Elementary Picture Day is Wednesday, September 29. Jr/Sr High School Picture Day is Thursday, September 30. Information and order forms will be sent home soon. We are once again partnering with Adirondack School Portraits from Glens Falls, who are great to work with and very experienced. You are not obligated to purchase photos, but every child will have their picture taken for school ID and Yearbooks. There will be a make-up/retake day on December 7, if your child is absent or you don't like their picture.

Our Fall Fundraiser will launch soon. Love it or hate it, this is how PTSA pays for most of the events and programs we offer. (Dancers pay for their classes and costumes.) We use a local fundraising company, based in Northville. Catalogs and details of an online store will be sent home soon. There is also the option of donating directly to PTSA if you can't

find something you like in the catalogs or if you'd prefer 100% of your money to come directly to PTSA. Unlike last year, we will be distributing catalog orders at school. Online orders are shipped directly to homes.

Planning for our Fall Book Fair is well underway. We will be utilizing a lot of things we had organized for the Spring 2020 Book Fair, when the theme was Jungle. Book Fairs are one of our biggest events and usually require the most volunteers. We are having to change the way we do certain things to work within COVID protocols, which will make our scheduling a little different. If you would like to help with our preparations for the Book Fair and Family Fun Night, please contact us via email. With the understanding Family Fun Night is very tentative and may not go ahead. A volunteer sign-up for the actual events will come out at the beginning of October.

Galway PTSA always appreciates your support. We understand the difficulties of juggling family, work, and home, particularly with young children. We are all volunteers, and value any time you have for PTSA. Some of our members work on projects at home - things like decorations for the Book Fair or Holiday Gift Shop. Some help plan events and logistics. Much is organized well ahead of time and is done through emails. Some events need people in school during the day – Picture Day, Book Fair, Holiday Gift Shop. These are a great way to meet other parents, see how the school operates, meet the teachers and aides, and possibly spend a little time with your child. Some events are during the evening – like Family Fun Nights, although we also know you might want to be there with your family.

Volunteer sign-ups are emailed to fully paid up PTSA members a few weeks prior to each event. If we are short of volunteers, we then open it up to everyone. You do not have to be a PTSA member to volunteer, except for positions handling money. Becoming a PTSA member costs \$6 per person. You can sign up the whole family, including students. You do not have to come to a meeting. You do not have to volunteer. You are not obligated to do anything. Your \$6 shows your support of PTSA and gives you greater access to what we're doing, as well as the opportunity to be part of our work.

We are always open to new ideas and suggestions. We definitely welcome your feedback. We are all busy parents, wanting to add a little more to our children's school experience and be part of our community.


In my spare time I enjoy spending time with my family, volunteering, doing DIY projects and spending time outdoors.

GALWAY PTSA & COVID PROTOCOLS

Since March 2020, we have been living with COVID. Most of us have stayed well, although we all know someone who's been affected. Last year we all experienced virtual school at some point, either as a choice, or when we were hit by quarantines – our own, and when too many school employees had to stay home. There is a good chance we could experience a pivot to virtual learning at some point this year, but we are very well prepared.

Wearing masks has been a contentious issue from the start. Galway PTSA was approached over the summer of 2020 about our stance on masks. We were again approached during the summer of 2021. On each occasion we have declined to make public statements or join the debate. This is for several reasons, all to do with how our organization is set up, it's governance and who we represent.

Our by-laws state the purpose of Galway PTSA is as follows:

- To promote the welfare of children and youth in the home, school, places of worship, and throughout the community. This is done through advocacy and education in collaboration with parents, families, teachers, educators, students, and the public; developed through conferences, committees, projects, and programs.
- To raise the standards of home life.
- To advocate for laws that further the education, physical and mental health, welfare, and safety of children and youth.
- To promote the collaboration and engagement of families and educators in the education of children and youth.
- To engage the public in <u>united efforts</u> to secure the physical, mental, emotional, spiritual, and social wellbeing of all children and youth.
- To advocate for fiscal responsibility regarding public tax dollars in public education funding.

We are a 501(c)(3) organization, organized exclusively for charitable, scientific, literary, or educational purposes. The following are basic principles of this PTSA in common with those of the National PTA and the New York State PTA:

- Galway PTSA shall be noncommercial, nonsectarian, and nonpartisan.
- Shall work to engage and empower children, families, and educators within schools and communities to provide quality education for all children and youth.
- Shall seek to participate in the decision-making process by influencing school policy and advocating for children's issues, recognizing that the legal responsibility to make decisions has been delegated by the people to boards of education, state education authorities, and local education authorities.
- Commitment to inclusiveness and equity.

Galway PTSA's membership and Officers have widely differing opinions on masks, vaccines, and other COVID protocols. We represent those who want our students to be mask-free, and those who would not send their children back to school without a mask. Ultimately, we all want a return to normal, to no masks, and no restrictions. We only disagree on the timing. We have a duty to represent everyone, and that is why we respect everyone's right to their own opinions. You will hear our individual voices on this subject, but as an organization, Galway PTSA will be adhering to Galway CSD policies. Our events in school will have the same mask requirements as regular school. Our volunteers, if they wish to help at events in the school, will have to abide by Galway CSD requirements for vaccination, COVID testing and masks.

We encourage everyone who feels strongly about this issue and any other, to get involved in Galway CSD. There are Board of Education meetings every month. Our administrators have always been open to communication from parents and the community. We all shared the experience of lockdown and saw our community coming together to do things for our children. Galway PTSA will continue those efforts and continue to build relationships with all our community.
